
Spring Festival 2001 in Beaufort Sets Palmetto Region Attendance Record

Our Spring Festival in *Beautiful Beaufort by the Sea* was a resounding success. At least 63 people representing about 34 Porsche families attended. 16 people traveled the 38+ miles from Bluffton Hilton Head Island to the

Beaufort Yacht and Sailing Club while 14 traveled the 46+ miles from Savannah and 23 traveled the 75 ± miles from the Charleston area. 10 covered the 20 miles or less from the immediate Beaufort/Okatie area and Zone III representative Dick Kjellsen and wife Carole drove from Atlanta.

The array of cars in the parking lot was awe-inspiring. The oldest Porsche—Paul and Marilyn Jones' 356 Speedster and the newest one (I think)—David and Joan Bodden's 996 Turbo. In between was an example of virtually every type of production car made by Porsche.




The First Spring Festival of the Palmetto Region was a success, and will go down in the PCA-Palmetto Region's history books as the largest attended meeting for our region.


