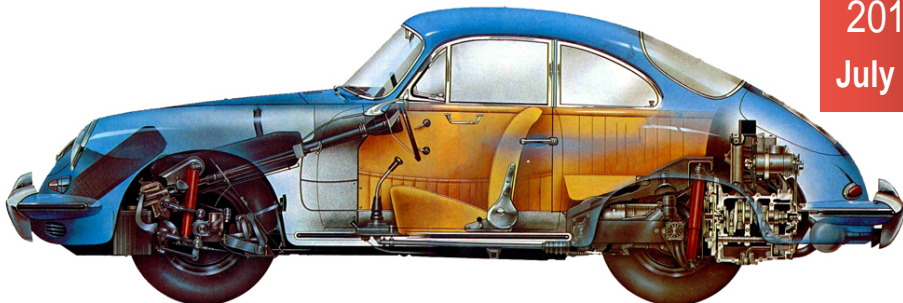

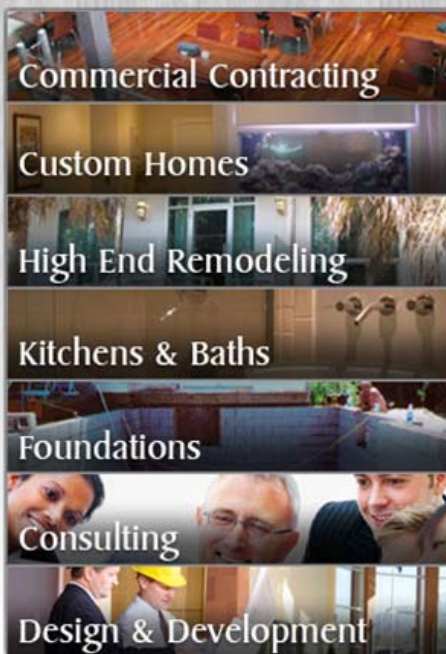

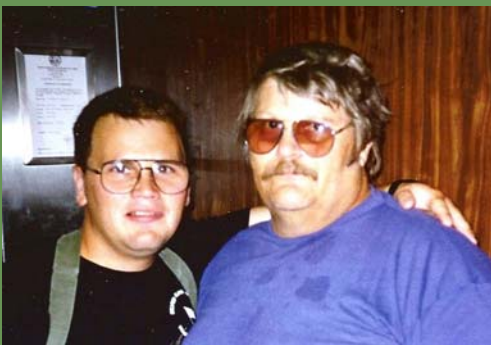
Since that time the Palmetto and Myrtle Beach Group have evolved into a great family of Porsche owners reaching through the Carolina's.

GERMAN RECIPE

“German Erdbeerbowle” – Strawberry Summer Punch

Erdbeerbowle is a wine punch with strawberries served at summer parties and German BBQs. Made with sweetened strawberries, lemon, wine and sparkling wine (German Sekt). It sets the mood of warm summer nights and tiki torches. Serve with cocktail picks to spear the fruit.

Prep Time: 20 minutes

Servings: about 10 cups (or 20 five-oz. servings)



INGREDIENTS:

2 quarts of strawberries, washed, cored and sliced
½ c. sugar, or to taste
1 bottle white, sparkling wine

2 lemons
1 bottle of dry, white wine
Mint or lemon balm to garnish

PREPARATION:

Sprinkle the sugar over the sliced strawberries in a bowl. Zest the washed lemons and then squeeze the juice. Add both juice and zest to the strawberries and let sit for 2 hours in the refrigerator. Drain and reserve the strawberry juice. Add the white wine to the strawberries and marinate in the refrigerator for 1 hour, or until the guests start arriving. Pour the wine and berries into a punch bowl, add the reserved juice and stir. Pour the sparkling wine into the bowl and serve.

To serve, ladle punch and strawberries into the glass, garnish with mint, if desired, and serve with a cocktail pick so that the guest can eat the strawberries.

“Neckar River” SOMETHING GERMAN

The Neckar River is a south to north flowing river through the southwestern state of Baden-Württemberg in Germany. A small section also travels through Hesse, Germany. The Neckar is a major right tributary of the Rhine River. In the conservation area Schwenninger Moos in the Black Forest near Villingen-Schwenningen the Neckar rises to a height of 706m (2,316 ft.) above sea level. The river passes through the towns of Rottweil, Oberndorf am Neckar, Sulz am Neckar, Horb am Neckar, Rottenburg am Neckar, Kilchberg, Tubingen, Nurtlingen, Wendlingen, Wernau, Plochingen, Esslingen, Stuttgart, Remseck, Ludwigsburg, Marbach am Neckar, Benningen am Neckar, Freiberg am Neckar, Besigheim, Lauffen am Neckar, Heilbronn, Neckarsulm, Bad Wimpfen, Eberbach and Heidelberg. The river finally discharges into the Rhine River at Mannheim, 95m (312 ft.) above sea level.

In the Neckar Valley from Plochingen to Stuttgart is densely populated and covered with industrial areas, including some very well-known companies such as Daimler AG Mahle GmbH. Between Stuttgart and Lauffen the river cuts a scenic meandering and in many places steep-sided valleys into fossiliferous Triassic limestone's and Pleistocene travertine. In the Odenwald hills section of the valley numerous castles can be found, such as Burg Hornberg and Burg Guttenberg in Habmersheim. The closed Obrigheim Nuclear Power Plant and the active Neckarwestheim Nuclear Power Plant are in this section of the valley as well.

Discharging nearly 5,100 cu. ft. of water into the Rhine, it is the 4th largest tributary. The Neckar is the 10th largest river in Germany. The name Neckar derives from *Nicarus* and *Neccarus* from Celtic *Nikros*, meaning *wild water* or *wild fellow*. Since around 1100 Black Forest wood was transported by timber rafting to Holland for use in shipyards.

In the 19th century traditional horse-drawn boats were replaced by steam boats, using a 155 km (96 mi.) chain in the river to pull themselves upstream. The introduction of the railway made it possible to transport timber to the port of Heilbronn. This limited timber rafting to the lower part of the Neckar after 1899. After construction in 1935 of 11 locks, ships up to 1500t could travel to Heilbronn. In 1968, the last of 27 locks at Deizisau were completed, making the Neckar navigable for cargo ships about 200 km upstream from Mannheim up to the river port of Plochingen. At Plochingen the Fils joins in and the Neckar bends, taking a Northwestern instead of a Northeastern direction. Important ports along the Neckar are at Stuttgart, Heilbronn and Mannheim.

During the summer months the course of the Neckar is very popular with cyclists. Near Trollinger its steep valley sides are used as vineyards. The name *Neckar* was also given to the first motorboat made during the summer of 1886 by Gottlieb Daimler and Wilhelm Maybach when their *Stranduhr* (grandfather clock) petrol engine was tested on the river near Bad Cannstatt.

River cruises along the Neckar are a good way to enjoy the river and its valley. It is one of Germany's most romantic rivers. During a river cruise you'll see ancient fortresses, ruined castles, well-preserved medieval towns and romantic nooks and crannies. In early spring fruit trees create a sea of blooms and autumn will bring golden colors.

STYLE PORSCHE IS AWARDED THE HONORARY TITLE OF 'RED DOT: DESIGN TEAM OF THE YEAR 2012' HIGHEST DISTINCTION FOR CHIEF DESIGNER MICHAEL MAUER AND THE STYLE PORSCHE DESIGN TEAM

Essen/Stuttgart: In appreciation of its uninterrupted great design performance, the Style Porsche design team has been awarded as the “red dot: design team of the year 2012”. Chief designer Michael Mauer and his team of 80 have been dedicated to the task of sustaining and advancing the Porsche identity across all model ranges since 2004. With the new Porsche 911 Carrera, the design team has triumphed in carrying forward the success story of the 911, which has spanned a period of nearly 50 years up to now. For this, the design icon was already awarded the “red dot” best of the best 2012” this year.

“That we won both of these most renowned awards this year makes me and my team proud indeed. It means we pursue the right design philosophy. With our work, we have ensured that a Porsche has always been a signature Porsche for many decades – from the 911 up to the Cayenne. The successful introduction of the new generation of the Boxster and the Cayenne, as well as the launch of the outstanding Panamera, are product coups without precedent.”

The presentation of the honorary title took place during the red dot gala in the Aalto Theater in Essen on the evening of July 2, 2012. 
