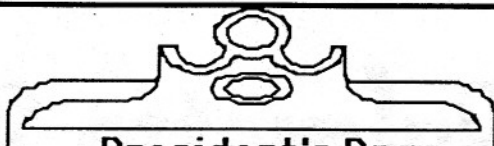

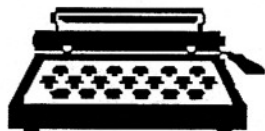


President's Page

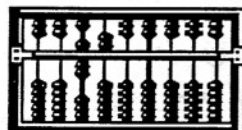

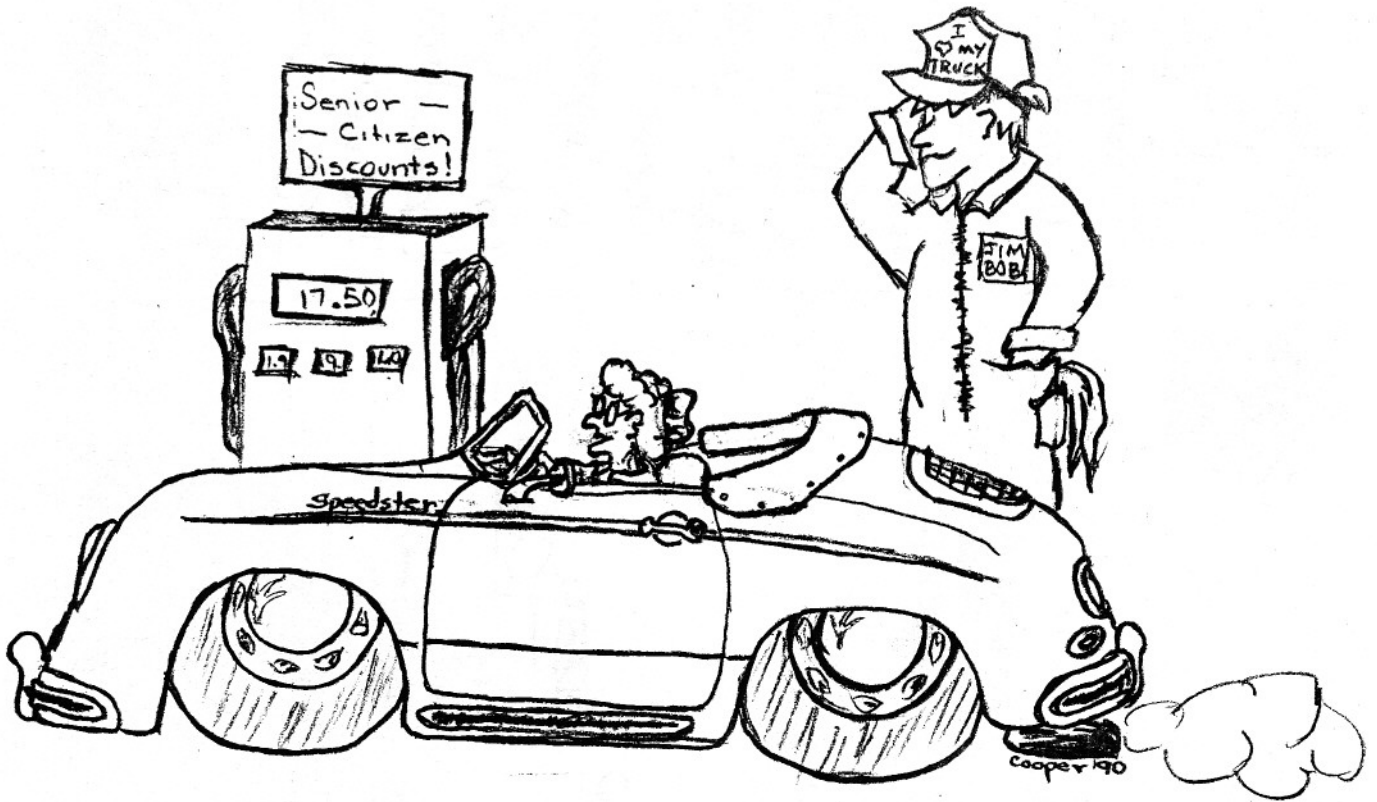
