## Beaufort or Bust

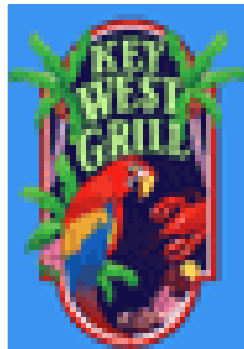

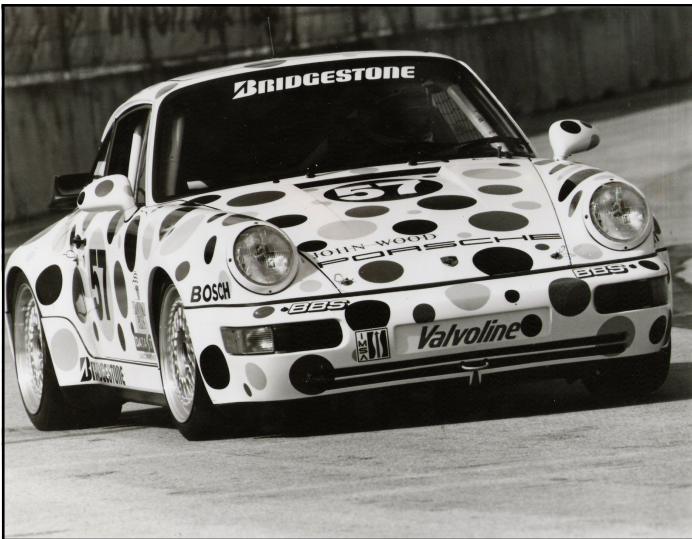
## 2006 Executive Committee Slate by the Nominating Committee
