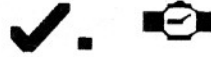

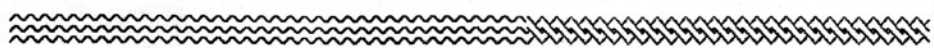
### 1.1 Mile Autocross

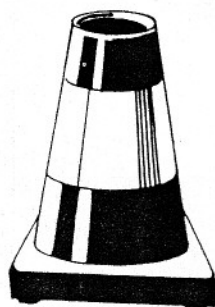
